SUPPORT OPTIONS

Option 1: Adopt One Learner

Support 50–100 learners per county
Enable scaled impact across communities

Option 3: Corporate Partnership

Fund county-level scholarship programs
Provide internships, mentorship, and job pathways

Option 4: Impact Investment

Support blended financing for education-to-livelihood pathways
